In addition, the programme includes a range of activities, creative workshops and guest speakers all in a virtual mode. It is a high quality programme for talented high school students who are in grades 9 to 12. Now in its fifth year, YSP successfully prepares high-school students for the academic and cultural life of university.

## **Programme Highlights**



- → Interactive classroom: Sessions on a range of academic disciplines like Economics, International Relations, History, Math, Psychology, Law and Society, Media studies and more. Classes are taught by eminent Ashoka faculty including Rudrangshu Mukherjee, Pratap Bhanu Mehta, Madhavi Menon, Jonathan Gil Harris and Ashwini Deshpande amongst others.
- → YSP Atelier: Workshops designed for enhancing experiential learning, to develop innovative thinkers and creative problem solvers.
- → Writing Sessions: Communication and writing classes to help develop academic writing as well as presentation skills.
- → Discussion Sessions: Small group discussions, using the Socratic method, where students are expected to ask questions, think critically, debate varied perspectives and build arguments.
- → **YSP Unwind**: Online social events to provide ample opportunity to interact with motivated peers and make lifelong friends.
- Guest Sessions: Inspirational speakers to introduce the students to Ashoka founders, distinguished scholars and practitioners in a wide range of fields, including public service, innovation and entrepreneurship.



# **Apply**

High School Students from all over India are eligible to apply. Students should be in grades 9 to 12 while they are attending the programme in December 2020. Students who are applying for the programme will need to fill an online application form giving high school marks, and submit an essay. They should demonstrate intellectual curiosity and have the ability to explore ideas.

YSP is a five day online programme wherein students will be engaged with educational content on virtual platforms during the December school break.
