What is an idea, concept, or theory that you find interesting and why? In what ways have you examined and engaged with this topic? [400 words]

Growing up in a small town in Assam, I was always encouraged to pursue the sciences and become a doctor or an engineer. However, I have always had an inclination towards the arts and have pursued it during my free time. This is how I came across the concept of 'mimesis', which, in Greek, means 'imitation'. As I delved deeper into it, I learned that Plato and Aristotle are the ones who expounded on it. For them, the world of art imitates the real world. While Plato thinks that imitation should be as close to the real world in order for it to be valued, Aristotle thinks that a piece of work is still valuable on its own despite its disconnect from the truth. As I began to research it, I also came across Oscar Wilde's 1889 essay 'The Decay of Lying', which claims that 'Life imitates art far more than art imitates life'. This was in stark contrast to Plato and Aristotle's concept of mimesis according to which 'art imitates life'. This was intriguing for me because I was faced by an opposing view on the concept of mimesis. Although I believe that every art form is an imitation of life and that it draws inspiration from life forms, I also think that there is some grain of truth to Wilde's claim. I believe that the artist has the ability to make the mundane things of life more beautiful. A flower or a scenery that I take for granted because I see it everyday might become more meaningful to me if I see an artistic vision of it. In a way, they can change how we see the world around us for better or worse. Having read both sides of the argument, I cannot decide which side I lean towards more. However, if there's one thing I've learned for sure, it is that artists wield immense power in shaping perceptions and this cannot be undermined.

Four years ago, there was a robbery at my neighbour's house. My neighbours were away on vacation and the robbers took a lot of their possessions, including money and jewellery. It came as a shock to me because I always assumed that I lived in a safe neighbourhood where crimes like this were unheard of. A part of my childhood innocence left me that day. I started becoming overly careful and suspicious of everybody. However, my neighbour's attitude to the calamity opened my eyes. Although they were sad for having lost their possessions, they didn't allow the incident to break them. Seeing them recover from the incident with smiles on their faces brought a certain level of maturity in me. It prompted me to retrospect on the value we give to material possessions, sometimes allowing them to overshadow what is more important in life.

'Prejudice' is one of my favourite words in the English language. It's special to me because it has helped me understand myself and the people around me better. For the longest time, whenever I came across the word, I saw it from an outside perspective. Somehow, I was convinced that I wasn't prejudiced and the word didn't apply to me. However, over the years, I've come to realise that I, too, am prejudiced. Maybe not to the degree that some people are, but to some degree for sure. Identifying my prejudices has allowed me to learn more about people and cultures and that, in return, has helped me to check my prejudices and expand my horizon. I am now a more empathetic person and I view the world around me with a better lens.
